



## Helpful Feis Hints

- When entering a feis remember that your age and category remain the same for the entire calendar year.
- When born on January first you remain the younger age.
- Your age is what age you are on January first of any given year.
- If you are born in 1998 you will be listed as Girls or Boys age 7 or Under 8.
- If you are born in 1989 you will be listed as Girls or Boys age 16 or Under 17.
- Your teacher is the only one who tells you to change your category mid season.
- When you compete at a feis you will either receive your number in the mail or it will be given out at the feis at the numbers table.
- The small numbers along the bottom represent the competitions that you are entered in. These are the numbers that you listen for and go around to each individual stage to find so that you'll know what stage you will be dancing on. Most times there is a program printed which will list the competitions that will be on the stages.
- Please remind your child what dance they are lining up for (Reel, Light Jig) the competition number will correspond to a particular dance. You do not want to do the wrong dance.
- Awards are posted. You look on the boards for your competition numbers and then look to hopefully find your number listed as a winner.
- Feis organizers and volunteers are usually very helpful. They try very hard to make the day run smooth.
- Most importantly remember to be a good sport and have patience.
